The Parish is committed to the safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults and to supporting those who have been victims of abuse, as well as those who may present a risk to others. The PCC has complied with the duty under Section 5 of the Safeguarding and Clergy Discipline Measure 2016 (duty to have due regard to the House of Bishops's guidance on safeguarding children and vulnerable adults). The PCC has adopted all the House of Bishops' Safeguarding Policies and Practice Guidance as well as "Promoting a Safer Church" (child protection and vulnerable adults policy) and the Domestic Abuse statement. All documents are available on the website and in the South Porch. Robin Bishop is the Parish Safeguarding Officer and concerns should be addressed to him.
